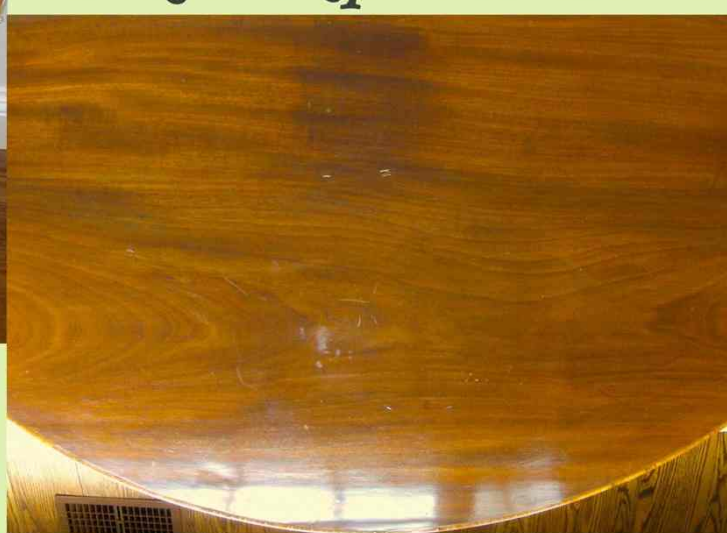
Glaring Gouge!

Our initial impression of this dresser top's damage was probably the same as yours! Ouch! The 1/4" deep gash was dramatic. However, with patience, on-site, we were able to return the dresser top to almost perfect condition.



French Polish brings life back to exquisite table!

Restoration doesn't have to be a major exercise. Sometimes minor, on-site work does it all! This lovely 1/2 moon table on the right had been scratched and scarred from use. On-site minor touch-ups and French Polish made a huge difference!



Original Victorian Finish Failed!

This original finish (left photo) was failing everywhere. After gently stripping the finish, we repaired the wobbly case, fixed the drawer glides, guides and stops, then refinished the whole dresser. In our view, a spectacular improvement!



Old World Asian Desk

You can clearly see the worn finish on the desktop (left). The solid top was also watermarked in a few spots. Once cleaned up and touched up, we added 8 more layers of French Polish. An excellent result, without the extra costs of stripping and refinishing!



Replacing missing table leaf



Replacing a leaf can be very costly. Both the leaf and the table top usually need to be refinished to coordinate colour, depth of finish and sheen. This customer asked only for something close to their antique Butternut table. We matched the shape, profile and colour.
